Minutes

1. Design codes

2. Business mapping across Consett Neighbourhood Area

Consett Area is not purely rural but has some rural issues, not purely urban but has urban issues. This lack of categorisation can cause issues with accessing support dedicated to these categories.

Christine recently met with Stuart Armstrong (Business Durham) who raised the question of whether Ian could work with him to do some business mapping of the area. This might be beneficial to us too, as this could be another layer in our GIS. This could also highlight undeveloped areas that could be useful for industrial (but not housing) or housing (but not industrial).
